First-cycle studies and long- cycle master's studies

Attention! A candidate's score below the required admission threshold in stage 1, will result in **0 (zero) points from the entire qualification procedure.**

Stage 2: entrance examination testing the knowledge or special aptitude required for admission to a relevant field of study

The number of points possible to obtain: **100**

Qualification threshold: **not lower than 50** (depending on the field of study).

- ✓ the scope, form, possible number of points, date and place of the exam will be published in the Internet Recruitment of Candidates system on the website: irk.uw.edu.pl no later than seven days prior to the date of the examination.

Attention! The final admission result is the arithmetic average of the results from both stages of the qualification procedure and cannot be **lower than 50 points** (depending on the field of study).

The application fee is **100 PLN.**

- ✓ **the NAWA's Director individual recognition statement** on a foreign document confirming the right to apply for admission to studies, as referred to in Article 70, sections 5b and 5d of the Act of 20 July 2018, the Law on Higher Education and Science, or an **administrative decision of the Education Superintendent** which confirms the eligibility to apply for admission to the first-cycle studies and long-cycle studies in the case where the proceedings for the recognition of a foreign document with regard to the eligibility to apply for admission to studies or the confirmation of obtained education were initiated before 30 June 2025.
